B - 1st Semester

ENGLISH HC-02 - British Drama - I

All the first 3 units (I, II & III) remain same except Unit IV & V

In unit-IV, Shakespeare's "Julius Caesar" was introduced instead of "Tempest"

In unit V, Ben Jonson's "The Alchemist" was introduced instead of Annotation.
