DATE-01.12.2021

Shailabala Women's Autonomous College, Cuttack organized an HIV AIDS Awareness rally and meeting on 1/12/2021. Hon'ble principal Prof. (Dr.) Surekha Sundari Swain and National President of Servants of the People's Society and Chief Administrative Officer of The Samaj newspaper Dr. Pravas Acharya showed green flag as a signal to start the rally from Samaj office at 10:00 AM in the morning. The volunteers of NSS and YRC of Shailabala Women's Autonomous College, Cuttack and program officers of NSS and YRC Counsellors participated in this rally with handmade placards, red ribbon symbols and marched to the college campus giving out slogans of HIV AIDS Awareness. After the rally an awareness meeting was organized in the college auditorium. Principal Prof. (Dr.) Surekha Sundari Swain presided over the meeting. Dr. Nivedita Pattnaik, M.D.(Paediatrics), Ex-Senior Resident Rainbow Children's Hospital, Hyderabad attended the meeting as resource person and discussed about the HIV Virus, mechanism of infection, stages of multiplication in human beings, symptoms of AIDS, methods to prevent, detect or control it. Since it spreads through infected blood and body fluids and secretions of reproductive tract it is recommended to avoid polygamy, sharing of needles, blades, unsafe sexual activities. One should get tested for detection of the virus in her body. It can be transmitted from infected mother to the child during gestation, delivery or breast feeding. The baby can be safe from contracting the virus if mother's HIV test is done prior completion of first trimester. The HIV infected person should be treated with compassion. Sharing of towel, food, bed, swimming pool with the infected person does not spread the disease. There are various methods to control the deadly HIV to cause AIDS. Thus knowing AIDS is the first step to winning it. A number of queries were put together by the students and the resource person answered to all those aptly. The program was co-ordinated by Dr. YogamayaPanda and Smt. Sushree Shibanee Dash, Program Officers of +3 NSS. YRC Counsellors of the college also co-operated in the program.

Outcome: The program served to spread awareness regarding HIV AIDS and its preventive measures. AIDs is a deadly disease. The program also helped the NSS volunteers to know about the diseases and other life-long health problems associated with it and how to extend compassion to the people affected or detected positive.
