It is apparent that the projected climate change leading to global warming, sea level rise and melting of glaers will disrupt the water balance in different parts of India and quality of ground water along the Coastal tract. Dr. Prasant Kumar Samantaray, Assistant Prof. of Botany discussed about that excessive use of natural resources results in excessive waste or pollution, so much that the nature is not able to absorb, broke it down and neutralise it. Dr. Ashok Kumar Nayak, Assistant Prof. of Zoology discussed about the impact of environmental change on Wildlife health. Dr. Biswadeb Mohanty, Assistant Prof. Physics, discuss about impact of climate change on Fistic and Botanica.
