1. OBJECTIVES OF THE MOU:

The objective of this Memorandum of Understanding is:

1. To work in tandem for the benefit of students of First Party "SBWAC" setting long term goals and involving students to enhance their employability skills for placements by reputed recruiters by second party free of any charges or cost.
2. To enhance the employability skills by encouraging students to participate in Skill enhancement Training, short term programs either through virtual (online) mode or offline mode free of any charges or cost;

3 To enable access by students of First Party "SBWAC" to training materials, E-books , Computer application software, etc as may be made available time to time by the Second party "IPSAR" as an integral part of the training and placement program.

4 To provide, train and assist students of the First Party "SBWAC" in minor and major projects on subjects and topics matching to the course curriculum for enhancing ability to understand, make critical analysis, and writing skills for preparation of project reports. Such minor or major projects may cover conducting field surveys, preparing questionnaires, data input and data analysis using application software and report writing.

2. SCOPE AND DESCRIPTION:

By this agreement, the parties would collaborate for all round personality development of students of the First Party "SBWAC" through short term trainings, workshops, quiz competition, group discussions, communication skills and mock interviews with a view to make them get through placement opportunities

3. TYPES OF TRAINING PROGRAMS

All the below mentioned workshops and trainings (hereinafter called as trainings) in the field of Computer Science and applications, Data Science and data Analytics, data visualization, Finance and Accounting, Statistical Research methodologies and tools for 3rd year students in Graduation and PG students in the field of computer, statistics, commerce and social science.

- i) **Basic Training:** Communication skills, use of application software's MS Word, MS Excel, Power Point etc.
- ii) **Middle level:** Subject topic discussion, analysis, presentations and writing skills
- iii) **Advance level:** Statistical tools for Data analysis, interpretation by use of application softwares and such other modes as deemed appropriate.

4. OBLIGATIONS:

- i) Both the parties shall establish a single person of contact (SPOC) for exchange of information;
- ii) Smooth conduct of the programs and dissemination of placement opportunities;
- iii) Schedules for trainings shall be discussed and mutually decided with agreement by both the parties;
- iv) Second Party "IPSAR" shall arrange trainers, teaching material (handouts/booklets) and material of trainings to be conducted.
- v) The First Party shall remain **free** of any financial obligation in any form whatsoever.

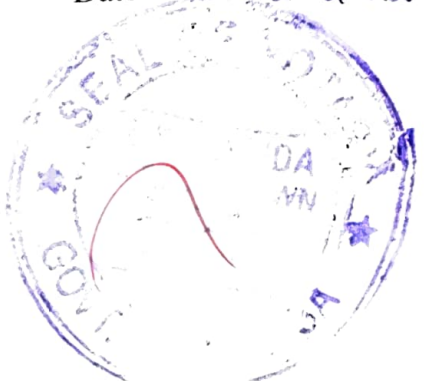

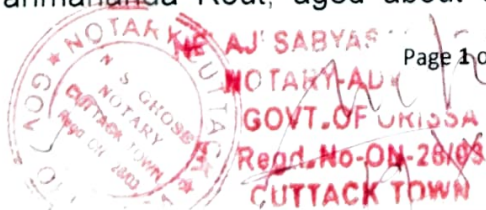


