**Outcome:** It taught discipline, coordination and respect for the National leaders of Freedom Movement to the cadets.

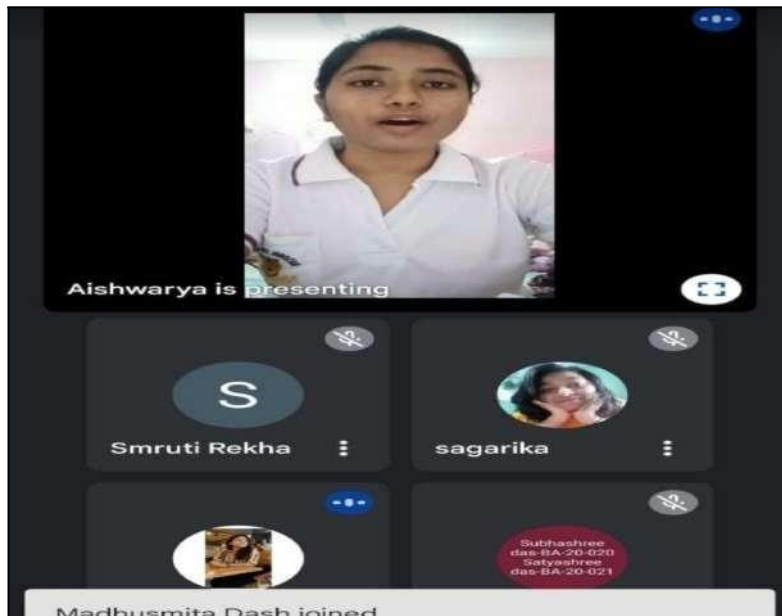


**WEBINAR ON "YOUTH OF INDIA"**

**Outcome:** The program united the participants to fight against HIV and to show compassion to the affected people.

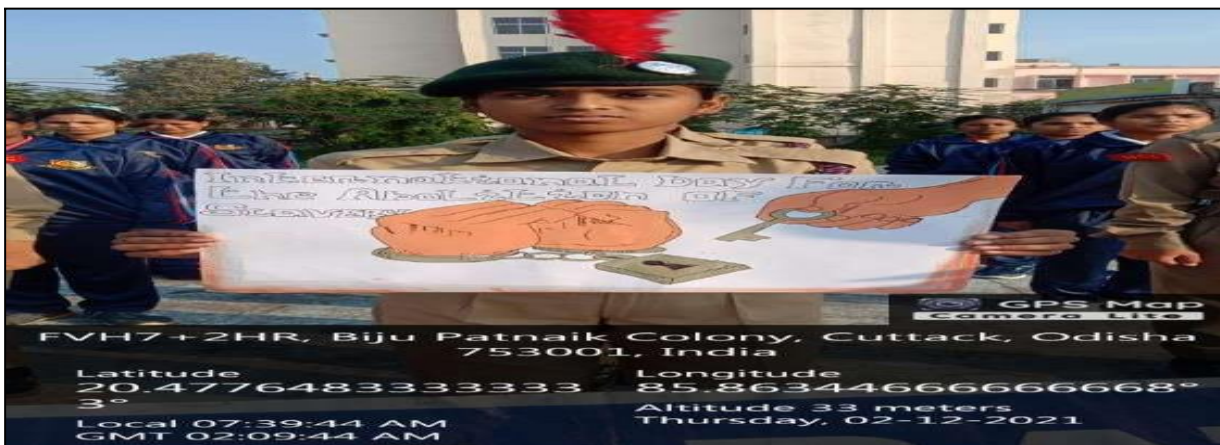


## INTERNATIONAL DAY OF ABOLITION OF SLAVERY

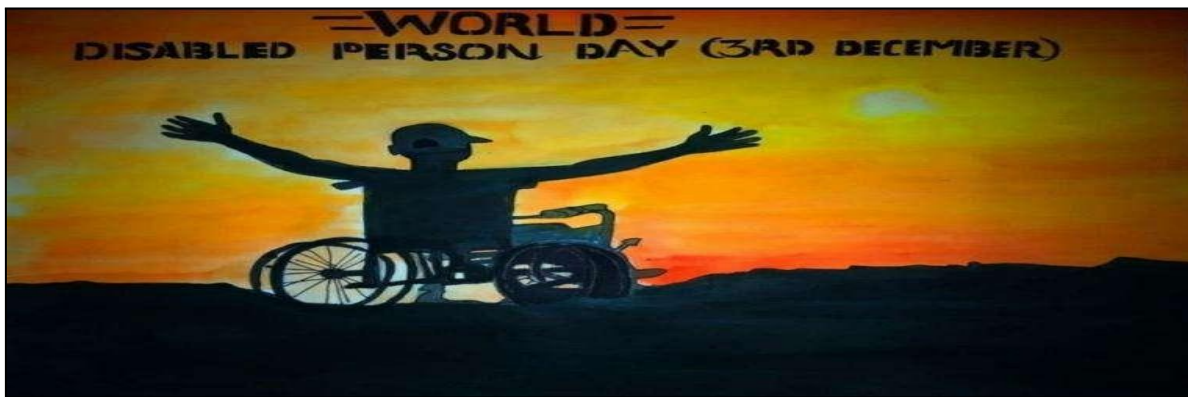


## **INTERNATIONAL DAY OF PERSONS WITH DISABILITY**

**Outcome:** The historic statues were made clean under the program.



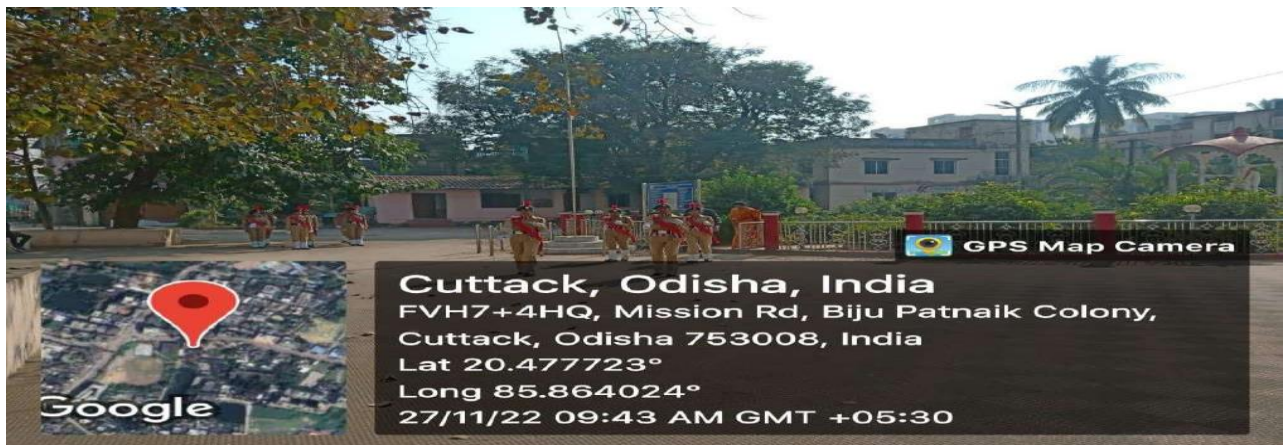
## NCC DAY CELEBRATION
